Students who enter the agreement for the four year guarantee are responsible for the following:

- Maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Pass pre-major and prerequisite courses with a grade of C or higher on the first attempt
- Complete course work as recommended by this plan each year for four years and meet all checkpoints. Some majors may require summer classes in order to finish in four years.
- Meet with your assigned advisor prior to registration each term to review your progress. Utilize the program evaluation degree audit tool available via the Chaminade University portal. Pay special attention to requirements that may be offered only once per year.
- Clear any holds on your account prior to the beginning of the registration period and enroll in classes within the first week of eligibility during the registration period.
- Accept any available course section that can be accommodated in your schedule of classes.
- Complete your clearance for graduation with your faculty advisor at the beginning of your fourth year.
- Notify your faculty advisor if you are unable to register for a required course in your major or for graduation.

Graduation Requirements:

- Satisfied all core curriculum requirements including nine credits of upper division course work outside the disciplines required for the declared major and the interdisciplinary course
- Satisfied all requirements for the major discipline
- Completed a minimum of 45 upper division credits
- Achieved a minimum GPA of 2.0 (some majors may require a higher GPA)
- Completed at least 30 semester hour credits in residence, including a least half of the credits in the major discipline
- Completed at least 120 semester hours
